

# Acacia pendula

## Weeping Myall



**Type:** Shrub/Tree  
**Size:** 10-20'H x 10-20'W  
**Exposure:** Sun  
**Flower Color:** Yellow  
**Bloom Time:** Spring

- Native to semi-arid areas of New South Wales, Queensland, and Victoria
- Good specimen tree
- Notable silvery blue-green foliage
- Narrow lance-shaped leaves (phyllodes) to three inches
- Ball-shaped flowers
- Flowering depends on soil moisture
- Weeping form
- Evergreen
- Slow growing compared to other Acacias
- Low litter rate
- Sensitive to root damage upon transplant
- Prefers well drained soil but will tolerate heavy soils with proper watering
- Drought resistant
- Frost tolerant 20° to 30° F
