

Acacia pravissima

Ovens Wattle



Type: Tall Shrub
Size: 15-20'H x 15-20'W
Exposure: Sun
Flower Color: Yellow
Bloom Time: Spring/Summer



- Native to New South Wales, Queensland and South Australia
- Name refers to irregular branching
- Easy to grow and highly adaptable
- Small triangle shaped leaves (phyllodes), like *A. cultriformis*
- Dull green foliage
- Small scented ball-shaped flowers
- Flowers in dense masses on stalks with 6-9 flowers per stalk
- Slightly weeping branches form vase-shaped form
- Can be used as a low windbreak or screen
- Evergreen
- Prefers well drained soil but will tolerate heavy soils with proper watering
- Little water needed once established
- Can be pruned after flowering
- Frost tolerant to 20° F
