

Acacia tetragonophylla

Kurara



Type: Shrub/Small Tree

Size: 6-8'H x 6-8'W

Exposure: Sun/Partial Sun

Flower Color: Yellow

Bloom Time: Winter/Spring

- Native to semi-arid and arid regions of New South Wales, central and southern Australia, and Western Australia
- Name refers to 4-sided leaves (phyllodes)
- Violet-scented wood with a grey bark
- Shiny bright green, slender, and rigid leaves end in sharp points
- Dense ball-shaped flowers
- Curled seed pods usually remain on the plant after they have shed their seeds
- Evergreen
- Great as a barrier plant
- Extremely hardy plant
- Suitable for sandy soil
- Drought tolerant
- Reasonably salt tolerant
- Frost tolerant to 20° F
